A Third Language - French and German are offered as optional subjects in our school.

For entry into National University of Ireland colleges:

A third language must be included among the other subjects for most degree programmes in Arts, Human Sciences, Law, Social Science, Commerce, Medicine and Health Sciences and some other degrees.

Students who have an exemption from Irish with the Department of Education, can apply for an exemption for Irish and/or a third Language through https://exemptions.nui.ie/ before applying for these courses in senior cycle.

A Third Language is also required for entry to the Cadets in the Defence Forces in Ireland.

It is not required for most courses offered in Technological Universities, unless there is a language element to the course, or for most Engineering and Science related courses.

Many of our students who speak and write fluently in another language (e.g. Polish, Lithuanian, Spanish, Portuguese, Japanese, Mandarin...) choose to sit this language as an additional subject for their Leaving Certificate. This is will often satisfy the requirement if the minimum grade is achieved. In most cases this is an O6 (40%+ in an ordinary level paper).

On the table(s) below choose subjects in order of the highest priority of preference (1, 2, etc).


